Do you want to help deaf adults develop a skill and career? Do you enjoy working with young people. Are you enthusiastic? Can you motivate students? We require CSWs to enable deaf students to access, as fully as possible, the curriculum and life in mainstream college. The successful candidate will need to present information in a form accessible to the student. The CSW will be required to pass on the information provided by the tutor/lecturer or other students in the class.

You must have a minimum of BSL level 3 or be willing to be trained to this level. Deaf First offers Sign Language courses from Level 1 to Level 6. You will need to have GCSE English and Mathematics (grade C or above), or a Level 2 in Literacy and Numeracy. Experience of work in the FE sector is desirable. We would welcome applications from CSWs who can also offer other forms of communication support, e.g. Note Taking/Lip Speaking if needed.
